Pace your activities Maintain a schedule (e.g. meals, rest times) Create a picture story of things you'll be doing Teachers will talk about schedule changes Classroom routines will be maintained Special activities will be minimal

The Nurse says: Flu Season is Here!

- 1. Children and parents should get a flu shot. If parents get sick, you are more likely to spread the germs to your children.
- 2. Help stop the spread of germs by teaching your child to cover their mouth and nose when coughing and sneezing. They can cough/sneeze into a tissue, their elbow or their shirt.
- 3. Wash hands with soap and warm water for about 20 seconds. Count to 20 or sing a short song while washing hands.
- 4. When sick, children should stay home for 24 hours after they are fever free without fever reducing medications
- 5. If vomiting, children need to stay home for 24 hours after they last vomit.
- 6. Notify the school if your child will be out sick and let us know their symptoms. This helps us inform others and keep our community healthy.
